

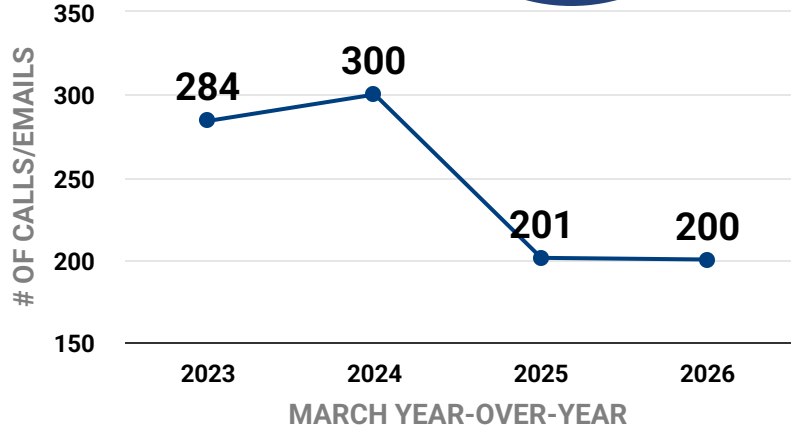

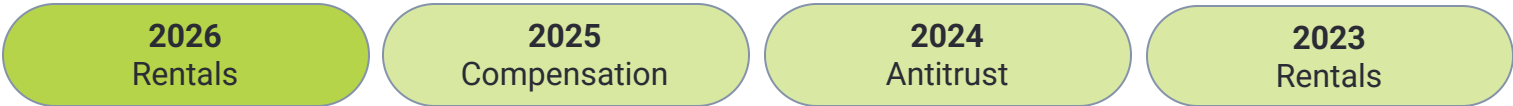

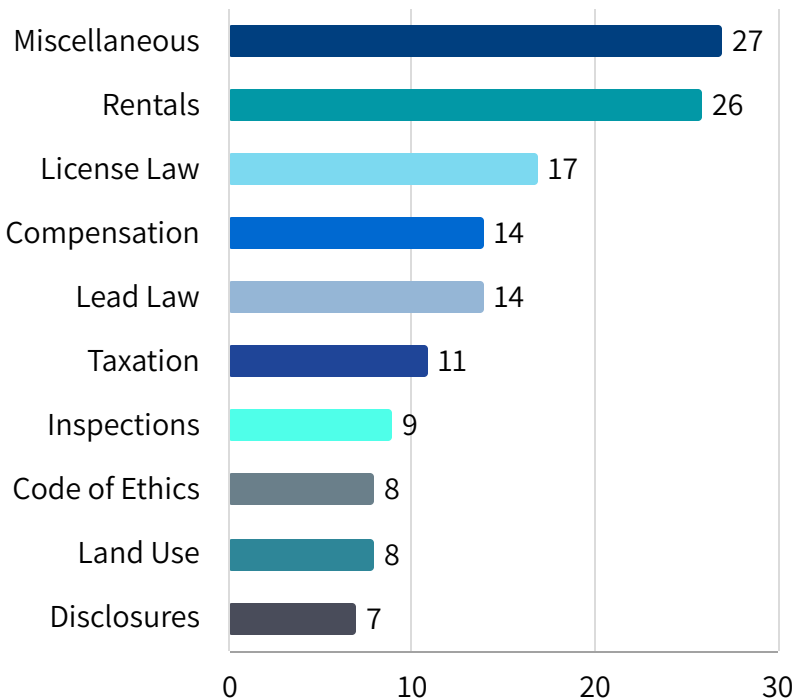
**Top Categories**

**March Q & A**

**I have been a real estate licensee for many years. Is there a time when I will be exempt from continuing education requirements?**

No. As long as you wish to have an active real estate license, continuing education requirements will continue to apply. The only exemptions are for licensees with a “valid license originally issued prior to December 12, 1984” and “attorneys licensed by and in good standing with the Rhode Island Supreme Court and granted a license pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-20.5-4(d).”
